



Biographic note: Dr. Urszula Radzikowska has earned her Ph.D. in the discipline of medical sciences from the Medical University of Bialystok, Poland. Her doctoral thesis explored the implications of rhinovirus-induced activation of the epithelial RIG-I inflammasome in the context of asthma and COVID-19. Building on her significant findings, Dr. Radzikowska is currently advancing her research career as a postdoctoral fellow at the Swiss Institute of Allergy and Asthma Research (SIAF) in Davos, Switzerland. Her work in the Immune Metabolism Lab primarily investigates the immunometabolic reprogramming of mucosal barriers associated with allergens and respiratory viruses, particularly in relation to allergy and asthma pathogenesis.
