



**Biographic note:** Dr. Sylwia Smolińska is a basic scientist specializing in clinical immunology. She graduated from the University of Wrocław in Poland, Faculty of Biotechnology, with a specialization in molecular biology. She subsequently completed her Ph.D. studies in medical sciences, specializing in internal diseases–clinical immunology, at Wrocław Medical University, Faculty of Medicine, Department of Clinical Immunology, where she is still employed as an assistant professor, leading scientific projects and teaching medical students.

Dr. Smolińska has received numerous scholarships, including the Ministry of Science and Higher Education Scholarship for Outstanding Young Scientists and the CK-CARE Scientist Exchange Program Scholarship. In addition, she has won many Young Investigator Awards as well as Abstract and Poster Prizes. For many consecutive years, her scientific achievements have been recognized with the Rector's Award at her Alma Mater. She has supervised several master's theses as a primary supervisor and Ph.D. theses as an assistant supervisor.

She has also held several board positions, including: Executive Committee Member of the European Academy of Allergy and Clinical Immunology (EAACI) from 2016 to 2020; Board Member of the Infections and Allergy Interest Group at EAACI from 2015 to 2017; Board Member of the Research and Outreach Committee at EAACI from 2019 to 2024, serving as Project Leader for e-Health/Telemedicine development; and Secretary of the Scientific Media Communication Committee at EAACI from 2023 to 2025, among others. She also works as an Expert at the Medical Research Agency in Warsaw, Poland.
